#### 4 TYPES OF CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

- 1. Zero conditional (always true)
- 2. Conditional type 1 (real condition)
- 3. Conditional type 2 (unreal condition) (มโน)
- 4. Conditional type 3 (impossible condition or past condition)

### ZERO CONDITIONAL (ALWAYS TRUE)

if clause

main clause

If X happens, Y happens.

(When) S + V1,

S + V1

- If you turn on the light, the room isn't dark anymore.
- When he presses the switch, the light comes on.

## CONDITIONAL TYPE 1 (REAL CONDITIONS)

if clause

main clause

If X happens, Y will happen.

$$S + V1,$$

$$S + will + V(inf)$$

- If he leaves now, he will catch the bus.
- If you can't come, contact me.
- Unless he leaves now, he will miss the bus.

## CONDITIONAL TYPE 2 (UNREAL CONDITION) (มโน)

If X happened, Y would happen.

$$S + V2$$
,  $S + would + V(inf)$

### If X happened, Y would happen.

- If I didn't have enough money, I couldn't buy you a gift.
- If I had enough money, I would buy you a gift.
- What would he buy if he had enough money?

If X had happened, Y would have happened.

$$S + had + V3$$
,  $S + would + have + V3$ 

fulfill

might + have could + have

#### If X had happened, Y would have happened.

- If John had had the money, he might have bought a car.
- I would have sent her a letter if I had found her address,
- If I had seen you, I would have said "hello".

•	If Susan takes her driving lessons regularly, she
	will pass (pass) her driving test.
•	If Charlie doesn't stop (not stop) eating
	these green apples, he'll soon feel sick.

## CONDITIONAL TYPE 2 (UNREAL CONDITION) (มโน)
