

Information on the opening of the relaxation point as a trading area in Dusit Bangkok

interviewed on February 3, 2021, Thaiwattana, D. & Totes, Y.

On February 3, 2021, an interview with the Dusit District Office of Bangkok found that the Dusit District area has "Grace Points". In addition, it was found that there was a market in front of the Department of Irrigation. Sangkalak Road (beside Vachira Hospital) Thewet Market Next to Wat Saphan Sung (fresh goods market) and Sriyan Market, the emphasis is on Best Service Rajawat rather than developing it into street food, but it cannot close the road. In a real view, we want Hawkers who think that the problem of the city (if you look at it from another angle) to manage to have cleanliness and orderliness for hawkers will become another charm and a focus of attention for tourists, just like foreign countries make it a selling point, adding value and value to hawker stalls without closing the road, but with appropriate space allocation. Emphasis on cleanliness, but if it is made into a walking street, it will affect the way of life of the villagers (investment may not be worth it and unsustainable). What is innovative is people, food, transportation. Lifestyle, hawker stalls, clean, systematic. Orderly, sustainable coexistence.
